# Definition of Productivity:

- A <u>measure</u> of the <u>efficiency</u> of a <u>person</u>, <u>machine</u>, factory, system, etc., in <u>converting</u> inputs into useful <u>outputs</u> **Business dictionary**
- Productivity is an average measure of the efficiency of production. It can be expressed as the ratio of output to inputs used in the production process, i.e. output per unit of input. When all outputs and inputs are included in the productivity measure it is called total productivity. Wikipedia




